How do I check if my laptop is working on battery power?

It does not occur when the charger is disconnected from the laptop first. The problem is unlikely to be OS related as it can be forced to occur even when the boot menu is displayed. More specifically the shutdown occurs when the battery is full, if it is charging from part-full, the problem does not occur.
