

Do you need documentation for a battery room?

The employer must know, document and train the employee for the assigned task and exposed risks. It is a requirement to have all the documentation in place prior to authorized personnel entering a battery room to perform a specific work task on a battery system under normal operating conditions.

How do I set up an UPS battery room?

Open-rack battery rooms must be adjacent to the UPS room. Battery cabinets must be adjacent to the UPS equipment. Cable lengths from multiple cabinets should be kept as nearly identical as possible to prevent voltage drop variations. One cabinet should be able to hold at least one complete string of cells.

Which battery configuration should I Choose?

Generally speaking, the larger the battery (both physically and ampere-hour rated), the more likely a rack configuration will be considered. There are no hard and fast rules, but typically once a battery unit (single-cell or multi-cell) gets above 100 AH, it favors rack-mount. Below that, cabinet mounting should be considered.

Can I carry a lithium ion battery?

From short circuit and unintentional activation. YES YES (see info) Lithium-ion batteries are limited to a rating of 100 watt hours (Wh) per battery. With airline approval, passengers may also carry up to two spare larger YES NO lithium-ion batteries (101-160 Wh).

Can a battery be placed in an ESWC?

The system's output may be able to be placed into an electrically safe work condition (ESWC), however there is essentially no way to place an operating battery or cell into an ESWC. Someone must still work on or maintain the battery system. Working on a battery should always be considered energized electrical work.

Do you need additional training to enter a battery room?

Additional training is necessary for that "qualified employee" to be qualified to enter a battery room to conduct a specific task. What they are trained for is no different than other training requirements. The employer must know, document and train the employee for the assigned task and exposed risks.
