

Why do I get a warning message about AC power adapter type?

Save the changes and exit from BIOS settings and now you'll never get the annoying warning message about AC power adapter type at startup. PS: Only use this method if your AC adapter is fine and in working condition. Sometimes this message may appear if your laptop battery or AC power adapter needs to be changed.

How do I disable the AC power adapter wattage & type warning?

Help disabling this Alert in BIOS &quot;Alert! How to disable power adapter warning on Dell Inspiron 5559?

Press the F2 key repeatedly when the computer starts up and you'll get to the BIOS screen. The Advanced section is towards the bottom; That's where you can disable the power adapter warning.
