How do I charge my IC recorder?

Slide the USB DIRECT slide lever on the back of the IC recorder and connect the USB connector to the USB AC adaptor. While the battery is charging, the battery indicator () is displayed in an animation. Now you can use the IC recorder while charging the battery. While playing back files using the built-in speaker, you cannot charge the battery.

How long does IC recorder take to charge a battery?

When you use the IC recorder for the first time, or after you have not used the IC recorder for a certain period of time, charge the battery continuously until " " is displayed. It takes about 4 hours to fully charge an exhausted battery. (*)

Why is my recorder not charging a battery?
