

How do I check the battery health of my Dell laptop?

Learn how to check the battery health status in BIOS, SupportAssist or ePSA Preboot System Assessment diagnostics, or Dell utilities such as Dell Power Manager or Dell Command | Power Manager. NOTE: Like most laptops, Dell laptops use lithium-ion batteries, which can swell due to battery age, the number of charge cycles, or exposure to high heat.

How do I Check my Windows 11 laptop battery health?

Thankfully, looking into the state of your Windows 11 laptop battery health is fairly straightforward, and can be done in pretty much no time. All that's really required is running a quick line of code through Windows' Command Prompt, then saving the resulting battery report as an HTML file you can then open in your browser of choice.

How do I track my battery usage?

Every drain over the last three days is tracked in the Battery Usage section. You can also get a full history of the battery's usage under the Usage History section. The Battery Capacity History section shows how the capacity has changed over time. On the right is Design Capacity, or how much the battery was designed to handle.

How do I view my battery report?

Click the [html link](#) to view the battery report. After clicking this [html link](#), your battery report will open in your default browser. From here you can check everything from 'Usage history', 'Battery capacity history', to 'Battery life estimates'. And there you have it.

How do I know if my battery has been used?

Check out the recent usage. The 'Recent Usage' section is under the 'Installed Batteries' section, and it shows the charge and usage history of your battery over the past 3 days. Review the 'Battery Capacity' section. This section, which is near the bottom, shows the capacity of the battery over a long period of time.

How to check battery life in Windows 11?

Open File Explorer and access the C drive. There, you should find the battery life report saved as an HTML file. Double-click the file to open it in your default web browser. The process works similarly in Windows 11. Right-click on the Start icon, but now you will select Windows Terminal (Admin) instead.
