Solar PV products are a significant export for China. In 2021, the value of China's solar PV exports was over USD 30 billion, almost 7% of China's trade surplus over the last five years. In addition, Chinese investments in Malaysia and Viet Nam also made these countries major exporters of PV products, accounting for around 10% and 5% respectively of their trade ...

China's solar cell production reached 1,088MW, accounting for 27.2% of the world's total output, becoming the world's largest producer of solar cells. However, by the end of 2007, only 100MWp of PV systems had been installed in China, accounting for about 1% of the world's cumulative installations.

Most of China's solar power is generated within its western provinces and is transferred to other regions of the country. In 2011, China owned the largest solar power plant in the world at the time, the Huanghe Hydropower Golmud Solar Park, which had a photovoltaic capacity of 200 MW.

China has emerged as a leading player in the global solar PV market. According to China's National Energy Administration (NEA), the country added 54.88 GW of solar PV capacity in 2021 comprising approximately 29.28 GW of distributed generation and 25.60 GW of centralized solar PV.

According to China Photovoltaic Industry Association, the country added 55 gigawatt of power in 2021, up 14% year on year, accounting for 33% of the global capacity. What's more, 58% of the world's PV modules (solar panels) came from China. Before being recognized as the largest PV maker, China's solar panel sector had been through a bumpy ride.

Reliable data showed that during the period, China's output of polysilicon, silicon wafers, solar cells, and modules all grew by over 30 percent year on year, and exports of PV modules rose by nearly 20 percent from the same period last year.

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
