

# Home energy battery shuts down as soon as the power is unplugged

Why does my laptop turn off when unplugged?

If you are facing the problem where your Windows 11 or Windows 10 laptop turns off when unplugged, even with a new Battery, then this post could be helpful for you. The most obvious reason for a laptop shutting down immediately after unplugging the power cord is that the battery might have gone bad.

Why does my computer shut down while in battery mode?

So, if the battery drivers get corrupted or are faulty, then the system may not be able to utilize the battery properly. Hence, your system may shut down while in battery mode. Uninstalling and Reinstalling the battery drivers should solve the issues that arise from faulty driver software. Let's go through the steps to do it.

Why does my laptop keep shutting down after unplugging?

Windows provides the function to change the power settings on both battery and plugged state. If the power settings are abnormally changed, your laptop may be shutting down after unplugging the power cable. For instance, the low battery percent may be fixed to 99 %, and the low battery action is changed to shut down.

How do I fix a low battery?

For instance, the low battery percent may be fixed to 99 %, and the low battery action is changed to shut down. Then, the system believes the battery to be at low capacity, and it may power off immediately when unplugged. You can fix this by reviewing the settings and reverting them to normal.

Why is my battery not charging?

And the answers you see saying it is a battery is actually usually the problem. Older batteries say they hold a certain % of a charge, but give false readings. Additionally if the new battery you bought was aftermarket rather than OEM it could also give you the same problem. You can also try the following...

Why can't I turn my laptop on without plugging in power?

If the computer cannot be turned on without plugging in the power, it is likely to be a hardware problem, because the initial process of booting is completely unrelated to Windows. If there is a problem, you need to contact the manufacturer of your laptop for further assistance. From your description, it should be unrelated to drivers.

If your laptop turns off immediately when you unplug it from a power source, it means your battery is not working. Most likely, your battery has reached the end of its useful life and has stopped holding a charge.

My laptop shuts down as soon as I unplug my charger. I tried the below method of troubleshooting: Unplug your Laptop and remove the battery. Press and hold the Power button for 30 seconds. Plug your laptop back in and replace the Battery. Start your PC. When I perform the above steps and then remove the charger, the laptop works fine ...

Most likely the battery has failed. I usually replace the batteries in my notebooks every 18-24 months. You can perform a battery check. <https://support.hp.com/us-en/topic/diagnostics?category=computing&issue=battery-adapter-issues>. The part number for the battery is 807956-001.

My battery was fine. Held a charge for hours. Then one day, it just stopped. The computer shows it to be 100% charged and in good health. When I changed the power scheme to Always Plugged In, it dropped to 96% charge and quickly came back to 100%. The battery is there and is charging, and is recognized by the system.

I've been having an issue lately with my surface pro 3 that renders it useless unless it's plugged in at all times. The battery icon displays an active connection, 100% charge and the LED light on the charger itself is staying on at all times (not flashing) but no matter what I do, the second that I disconnect the power supply, it shuts down and displays a low battery icon.

Suddenly shuts down when battery reaches about 60%., but no shut downs when plugged in. An additional thing in my case is that the battery basically stops charging/starts charging extremely slowly at about 85-90%. I'm not sure if this makes it more or less likely to be a battery issue. Obviously want to be sure it is indeed a battery issue ...

Possible troubleshooting steps and repair solution: First of all, test the power adapter. Make sure the adapter outputs correct voltage. It's possible that the output voltage is not correct and the laptop shuts down to prevent the damage. Test your laptop with another known good power adapter.
