

How to remove the built-in battery for charging

How do you remove a battery from a laptop?

First, shut down the laptop and unplug it from any power source. Next, locate the battery release latch or button. It is usually located on the bottom of the laptop or near the hinge. Press or slide the latch/button to release the battery from its compartment. Carefully lift the battery out of the compartment. What if the Battery Is Built-In?

How do I disable a built-in battery?

Select Disable built-in battery and press Enter. Select Yes in the Setup Confirmation window. The built-in battery is disabled and the computer turns off automatically. Wait three to five minutes to let the computer cool. Was this information helpful?

How do I remove the Charger from the battery?

To remove the charger from the battery in the Prestolite Power Owner's Manual 193111 068, disconnect it from the battery and the input AC. Blow out the charger with compressed air, and allow it to set unused for 1 to 2 weeks in a warm dry environment (as hot, up to 104°F) and dry as possible.

Can I remove a battery from my HP laptop?

Opening the laptop chassis to remove the battery will void your warranty. Several components could get damaged by when you attempt to remove the battery. The battery could be a proprietary design that needs specialized tools to remove. You may not be able to purchase an authorized HP battery to replace the proprietary design.

Do I need to remove the battery to charge the battery?

You do not need to remove the battery to charge the battery. When you connect the charger you MUST be careful to connect the charger's positive lead to the positive terminal to the battery and the negative lead to the negative lead to the battery before you turn on the battery charger.
