

How do you reattach a battery to a watch?

If there's a clip holding the battery in place, insert a small screwdriver into the hole and press up to disengage it. Then, pry the old battery out of the casing with plastic tweezers, discard it, and push the new battery into place. Be sure to check that the watch is working before reattaching the back!

How to put a battery in a watch?

The edge of the battery just has to be popped under the lip C and then pressed down. The battery and back of the watch can be covered with a piece of polythene bag while pressing in order to protect from finger dirt. After the battery is inserted the screws A & B (see below) must be tightened. NOTE: ?Not sure that it is necessary to loosen screws.

How do you remove a battery from a watch?

These are the type of screwdrivers made for the small screws found in watches. They have a loose rotating knob on the end which allows them to be pressed down onto a screw with one finger while the others (gripping the splined sides) are used to rotate it. To take the battery out I had to loosen two screws A & B (see below).

How do you replace a battery?

Wear a pair of dust free latex gloves when replacing your battery. Slip a sharp tool into the indentation. Find a tool that's small enough to fit into the indentation you discovered. Tools like a small flathead screwdriver created for eyeglasses or a small blade may fit it into the indentation. Twist the tool to pop off the back casing.

What is the correct battery for my watch? In order to identify the correct replacement battery for your watch you will need to know the battery code.

For watches with screw-down backs, carefully position the back over the casing and use a case back opener with adjustable pins or a specialized wrench-like tool to rotate and screw down the back in a clockwise direction. As with screw-off backs, avoid over-tightening to prevent damage to the casing threads.

Rotate the battery away from the board (Figure E), until the 2 clips are released (Figure F). To install the new

battery pack, simply reverse the steps taken to remove the battery.

To insert the battery in your CAT S22 FLIP, follow these steps: Using a coin, rotate the battery door screw on the back of the phone counterclockwise several times to loosen. Remove the back cover of the CAT S22 FLIP. Insert the battery. Replace the back cover. Using a coin, rotate the battery door screw clockwise until it is tight.

When dealing with screw-back cases, align the case back with the watch and use a case back opener tool to rotate the screws clockwise, securing the case back in place. Exercise caution to avoid overtightening the screws, as this could damage the case or compromise the watch's components.

Charge the battery. Plug it into a power source using the provided USB cable. Once the battery's fully charged, only one light on top will glow green. Re-insert the battery. Slide the battery back into the camera until it clicks into place. Twist the battery compartment cover clockwise to lock it and tighten the security screw.
