How do I fix a computer not working without a battery?

Remove your battery and clean any dust in the connectors. Plug in your charger and press the power button. If your PC can work without a battery, allow it to boot up completely and shut it down again. If it can't work without a battery, press and hold the power button for over 30 seconds.
