

How much does a 5 year battery warranty cost?

That means for the third year of your warranty on that "five-year" warranty, you will have now paid \$232.50 (\$150+\$82.50) for your battery, assuming the price of the battery didn't increase after you bought it. If it did, you might end up paying a little more, as the SRP is at the time of warranty replacement, not the original purchase.

How long does a car battery warranty last?

A typical car battery warranty will last approximately two years or up to 240,000 miles. After that time, you may have to pay a portion of the replacement battery costs, depending on the type of warranty it carries. Some manufacturers are moving away from pro-rated warranties and offering 3, 4, or 5-year warranties instead as better alternatives.
