What is a Rollei 35?

The Rollei 35 is a 35mm miniature viewfinder camera built by Rollei. The original Rollei 35, when introduced at Photokina in 1966, was the smallest existing 135 film camera. The Rollei 35 series remains one of the smallest 35 mm cameras after the Minox 35 and Minolta TC-1. In 30 years, about 2 million Rollei 35 series cameras were manufactured.

What kind of battery does a Rollei 35 use?

Books, Users Manuals For Sale. The Rollei 35 cameras including the Rollei 35S, that have an analog meter, (light reading needle and follow pointer needle). They were originally calibrated to use the 1.35V PX 625 battery.

What battery do I need for a Rollei 35 LED camera?

The camera requires a PX27 battery to operate, which is currently no longer available. Alternatively, you can use LR44 batteries (eBay / Amazon *) with an adapter. The Rollei 35 LED relies on the use of 35mm film. This format is characterized by its reliability and simplicity, which is why it is still produced by various manufacturers.

Why should you buy a Rollei 35 LED camera?

Despite its small dimensions, the Rollei 35 LED impresses with its ability to produce excellent images. A crucial factor for this is the integrated lens. The camera is equipped with a fixed lens, more precisely the "Triotar 40 mm f/3.5". When inactive, this is retracted into the camera housing to maintain its handy size.

How much does a Rollei 35 LED cost?

The value of the Rollei 35 LED varies depending on its condition and functionality. Although a large number of these cameras have been produced, it remains a popular model that can still be used without any problems. Therefore the price is often in the three-digit euro range. The current average used price for a Rollei 35 LED is 260,78 Euro.

Where were Rollei 35 cameras made?

Mass production of the Rollei 35 started in 1966 in Germany and the camera was an immediate hit. These early cameras have "Made in Germany by Rollei" on the back. But in 1967 production moved to Singapore. The German cameras are quite rare and considerably more valuable than their Singapore equivalents.

Battery: Designed to take a 1.35v MR-9 battery, which is no longer mass produced. The great thing about the T and S meters is that you can read them and set the camera one-handed. It's not as easy ...

If your Rollei 35 work with a PX625 1,35 volt mercury battery, you can use a 1,55 silver oxide battery insert in an MR-9 adaptor sold by C.R.I.S. Camera Service. The MR-9 have a micro electronic circuit that reduce the voltage from 1,55 to ...

The Rollei 35 was launched at Photokina in October 1966 to great acclaim. The production from 1966 to ... 35,35T and 35S have a match needle analogue meter situated on the top plate of the camera and powered by an EPX625 1.5v battery. Originally theses models required a mercury cell 1.35v battery but these batteries are no longer available. Most cameras have been ...
