

What if my laptop doesn't have a battery?

If your laptop thinks there's no battery present, perform a full shutdown, unplug the power cable, and physically remove the battery. Then, place the battery back in, reconnect the charging cable, and then power on your laptop.

How do I fix 'no battery is detected' error?

Often we can fix the 'No Battery Is Detected' error by removing and reinserting the battery, updating BIOS/drivers, calibrating the battery, or replacing it. With patience, we can usually restore your laptop's battery capabilities. Once resolved, we can utilize your laptop's portability without issues.

Why is my laptop battery not detected?

No battery is detected. Battery #1: Not present. Consider replacing your battery. The battery is not detected. No battery present. Laptop battery not detected error messages are usually triggered by physical damage to the battery or laptop hardware, out-of-date drivers or other software, or overheating.

Why does Windows 11 say no battery is detected?

If the error remains, it could be caused by a corrupted battery driver. In that case, you can try uninstalling the driver instead. Restart your PC after that to allow Windows to install the removed driver again. At times, issues with your PC's BIOS can also lead to the "No battery is detected" message on Windows 11.

How to fix battery not charging problem Windows 10?

To see if Windows can fix the battery not charging problem, you can run the power troubleshooter. 1. In the search type "troubleshoot settings" and then click to open them from the search results. 2. In the 'Troubleshoot' window, select Additional troubleshooters. 3. Scroll down and click on Power.

If the battery is subjected to a recall, you are automatically connected to a replacement order form. You need the Dell laptop Service Tag or the battery PPID (serial number) for this ...

arrow to the left of your notification icons on the taskbar. If you see the battery icon here (an area Microsoft calls the "notification area overflow pane"), simply drag and drop it back to the notification area on your taskbar.
