

What does the Samoa Water Authority do?

The principal purpose of the Samoa Water Authority is to provide water supply, wastewater services and other services mandated under SWA Act 2003 for all the people of Samoa. It continues to provide focus to achieve their linked Vision and Mission statements as stated below:

Does Samoa have a drinking water system?

It has built up its system of treatment plants and supply pipelines. It has also built a waste water treatment plant to treat and dispose of sewage from the Apia town area and the national hospital. Since 2008 Samoa has had national drinking water standards and SWA has established laboratory facilities and a testing regime to ensure it meets those.

What is a water truck in Samoa?

Water meters were introduced in Samoa by 2003 to help our customers conserve water and improve the Authority's billing system and debt collection. Water Truck is available for purchase for non-SWA customers at an affordable pricing. However, it can be offered to our registered customers if they are experiencing no water only if the bill is cleared.

Why do I need a water meter in Samoa?

The Authority offers a free survey to any bill dispute to check if there are any non-visible or neglected water leaks within households and lands that could have caused high bills. Water meters were introduced in Samoa by 2003 to help our customers conserve water and improve the Authority's billing system and debt collection.
