What happened at a Turkish ammunition factory?

ISTANBUL (AP) -- An explosion at an ammunition factory in northwest Turkey left 11 dead and five injured Tuesday morning. The blast occurred in Balıkesir province, according to the state-run Anadolu Agency. The factory is in a rural area away from population centers.

Why are batteries exploding in South Korea?

Other fires in South Korea and elsewhere have involved explosions from other causes, including a vulnerability of some batteries to operate at abnormally high temperatures under certain fault conditions (Yonhap News Agency, 2020).

What happened at an armament factory in Turkey?

An explosion at an armament factory in northwest Turkey left at least 12 dead and four injured Tuesday morning. The blast occurred in the capsule production facility of the factory located in the province of Balıkesir, according to the state-run Anadolu Agency.

What happened at a lithium battery factory?

Security camera footage showed the fire sparking from a stack of batteries and quickly engulfing the factory where 35,000 lithium batteries were stored. The spread of toxic smoke probably rendered workers unconscious within seconds, fire officials have said. Seventeen of those who died were Chinese, and one was Laotian.

What happened to Aricell batteries?

On 24 June 2024, in Hwaseong, South Korea, a lithium battery factory owned by Aricell caught on fire after several batteries exploded. The fire killed 23 workers and wounded eight more, mostly Chinese nationals. Aricell manufactures non-rechargeable lithium-thionyl chloride batteries.
