

# The battery broke after reinstalling the system

Does reinstalling Windows cause battery damage?

It's incredibly unlikely that reinstalling Windows would cause hardware damage to the battery. It is more likely that the battery broke coincidentally right as you were reinstalling Windows. The sequential occurrence of two events does not imply causation. You must log in to answer this question.

How do I fix a bad battery?

Run Troubleshooter Open Settings => Update & Security => Troubleshoot => Power => Run the Troubleshooter. 4. Update BIOS if available. if not, just reset it to default. 5. Try different charging cable. If none of the methods resolve the problem, check the battery health.

How do I fix a battery not charging after Windows Update?

Here's the solution that worked for me: go to Windows Update - Repair, and install the latest repair version available. The battery started charging immediately, even while the installation was still in progress I am using update (KB5045991). Battery not charging. Stuck on 0%. I am using an ASUSTek laptop.

Why is my laptop battery not working?

If fans don't spin /screen backlight doesn't light up /BIOS loading screen do not display when you press the power button with the AC removed, then the battery itself is likely damaged. Or, much less likely, a BIOS update broke it.

Why is my battery draining so fast?

These could be draining the battery faster. However, first go into your "Control Panel" and then "Power Options". In there click on "Change plan settings" next to whatever setting you are using. Then click on "Change advanced power settings". In the window that pops up, go through all the sections and make sure everything is set to run as you want.

How do I replace my laptop battery?

Replace Battery. Step 1. Check Power Supply and re-install the Battery module. Before troubleshooting further, it's important to make sure you're using the correct AC charger for your laptop and that the battery pack is properly seated.
