How do photovoltaic cells work?

The photovoltaic cells are placed in a piece of equipment, called solar stringer, that interconnects the cells in a series by soldering a coated copper wire, called ribbon, on the bus bar of the cell. What is a photovoltaic module?

For real-world applications, photovoltaic modules are fabricated by electrically connecting typically 36 to 72 solar cells together in a so-called PV module. A PV module (or panel) is an assembly of solar cells in a sealed, weather-proof packaging and is the fundamental building block of photovoltaic (PV) systems.

How a photovoltaic module is assembled?

The assembly of photovoltaic modules consists of a series of consecutive operations that can be performed by automatic machinesdedicated to optimizing the single production phases that transform the various raw material in a finished product.

How is a PV module manufactured?

The schematic process flow for the fabrication of a PV module is shown in Fig. 2. These strings are typically inspected by electroluminescence imaging to identify defects early on in the production process.
