

What happens if a car fails a vehicle inspection in Vietnam?

If a vehicle fails the inspection, the owner must make the necessary repairs and have the vehicle re-inspected. The PTI is conducted by a government agency called the Vietnam Register. Are motorcycles required to be inspected in Vietnam?

All privately owned automobiles and commercial vehicles in Vietnam are required to undergo regular vehicle inspections. There are no required roadworthiness tests for motorcycles. Conditions to satisfy the requirements for roadworthiness are different for private cars and for commercial vehicles that are used to transport goods or passengers.

How often should a car be inspected in Vietnam?

Following the initial testing, vehicles need to be inspected every 18 months. Any inspection required after the initial certification can be done at an authorised inspection centre in Vietnam. Passenger cars that are more than 15 years old must be inspected every three months, as well as trucks that are more than 20 years old.

Subsequent inspections cost VND 100,000, with an additional fee of VND 100,000 for the issuance of the certificate. Once the vehicle has passed the roadworthiness tests, a certificate of inspection is issued. The owner is given a stamp that must be attached to the upper right corner of the vehicle's windscreen.
